2023 – 2024**

Action Taken Report

Introduction:

The College notified the Students to submit online students' satisfaction survey within the stipulated period for the academic year 2023-24. The students were given online link on the What Sapp group and e-mail. They were given a questionnaire of 24 questions related to the overall teaching – learning process, facilities and amenities available and infrastructure of the institution. There were 290 students reported their online responses on the performance of the institution out of 490 students. As per survey, the following considerable common suggestions were given by the students -

Area of action to be taken (Suggestions by the students):

S.No.	Suggestions
1	More sports facilities be improved on the college campus
2	Canteen facilities be improved and upgraded
3	More reference books be added for PG and B. Sc. streams
4	Toilets and washrooms be cleaned regularly
5.	Waiting room for girls be made available
6.	More facilities of competitive examination be made available
7.	More activities for placement cell be arranged for the students

Action taken for improvement:

As per responses given by the students, more than 90 % students were strongly agree and agree with infrastructure, equipment and learning recourses of the college. The suggestion related to classroom cleaning, canteen facilities, library facilities and sport facilities were given by few students. On the basis of students suggestion the institution management had taken action as follow-

1. The principal, Dr. Sunil Helkar called the meeting of Gymkhana Committee for the discussion on increasing more sports facilities as per suggestion made by the few students. The Physical Director of the Sports Department gave information about the sport facilities available in the department. The principal informed to increase sport facilities and amenities for the students. As per instructions following action was taken to improve sports facilities.
 - The college purchased sport equipment and sport kits
 - The college upgraded running track
 - The college prepared cricket peach and groundThe college received PM-USHA grant for overall development of the college. The sports equipment and ground would upgraded in the forthcoming year.
2. The principal discussed on the suggestion made by the students regarding the canteen facilities be improved and upgraded. The Canteen Committee called the caterer of the canteen and gave necessary suggestion for the improvement and up gradation of the canteen facilities. As per instructions given to the caterer the following improvements were made -
 - The caterer started to keep food as per demand of the students.
 - Clean and fresh food was kept in the canteen.
 - The cleanliness and tidiness was maintained.
 - The canteen kept open during the working hours of the college.
3. As per suggestion of the students to increase the number of reference books for PG and B. Sc. Streams, the principal called the meeting of Library Committee to sort out the issue. As per suggestions of the NAAC PEER Team, the college has started new courses such as M. Com. and B. Sc. for the convenience of the students. As per instructions given to the Librarian, some more reference and text books were being purchased as per requirement of the staff and students.

4. The students suggested to keep toilets and washrooms cleaned regularly. As per the suggestion, the principal discussed the issue with the office superintendent. The following measures were taken for the improvement
 - The man assigned for cleaning of toilet and washroom was instructed for his task
 - The college staff was kept to observe cleanliness regularly
 - The college staff was instructed to open and close the toilets and washrooms in time.
 - The college staff also instructed to make available adequate water in the toilets and washrooms.
5. The assigned waiting room for girl students is inconvenient. The waiting room for girl students required to pay more attention. Being introduced new courses, the college was unable to avail the waiting room within the existing academic building. After the completion of proposed building contractions, the college would able to make available convenient waiting room and additional toilet and washroom for the girl students.
6. As per suggestion quoted by the students to provide more facilities of competitive examination for the students, the principal called the meeting of the Competitive Examination Committee and discussed multiple measures to make the center more functional. As per instructions made by the principal, the following measures were taken for improvement.
 - More guest lectures were arranged for the guidance
 - More books were purchased for competitive examination
 - Additional schedule of coaching by the expert staff was arranged.
 - Additional borrow card facility was given to the admitted students for the study.
7. The college had formed Placement Cell to monitor placement activities on the college and off the college campus. As per discussion and instructions received, the committee took the following steps –
 - The Placement Cell organized entrepreneurship programs in collaboration with TATA Consultancy and Mahindra Pride Classrooms to make the students job hunters.
 - The cell arranged mock interview event guest lectures for the improvement of employability skills among the students.
 - The college started Pre-recruitment Training Center in collaboration with Raje Shivaji Career Academy


Outcome:

1. The sport students were quite happy with the available sport facilities. Saloni Lankeshwar participated in the University Holleyball Team. Suraj Magar stood second place in the Wrestling Tournament.
2. The caterer started to take extra care to keep cleanliness in order to maintain hygiene of the students. He started to take more care for the quality food available in the canteen. The students started to enjoy improved facilities in the canteen.
3. The new reference and text books supported the students at their studies. The university result of the college was more than the university result in percentage. More than 70 % studnets got first class and distinction in the university examination.
4. The students are made available clean toilet and washroom facility. It helped them to keep them healthy and hygiene.
5. The college made available waiting room in the Women Hostel that is near to the academic building of the college.
6. The competitive Examination Center became more functional. The students started to participate in the activities more actively. They understood the nature and scope of the competitive examination and importance of the competitive examination in career building. The activities of the center supported them for their preparatory study of the competitive examination.
7. The activities conducted under the Placement Cell imbided soft skills among the students. The students learned how to face interview sessions for the job. Few students were placed under the guidance of the cell.
